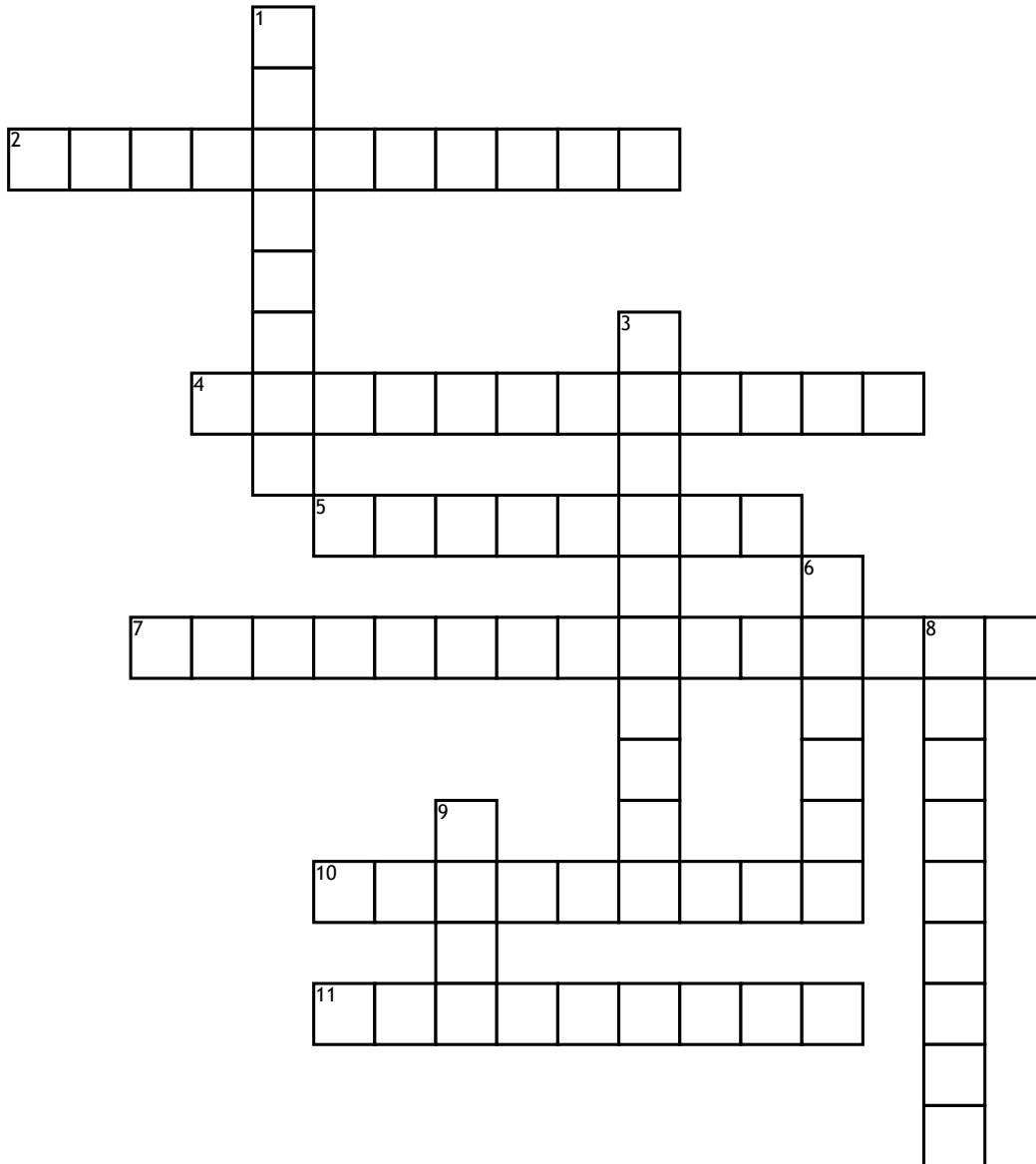

- 2. a long, deep, and narrow depression in the ocean floor, typically marking a subduction zone
- 4. The man who discovered Continental Drift, or plate tectonics
- 5. break between an upland region of relatively hard crystalline basement rock and a coastal plain of softer sedimentary rock
- 7. a fault in which rock strata are displaced mainly in a horizontal direction, parallel to the line of the fault.
