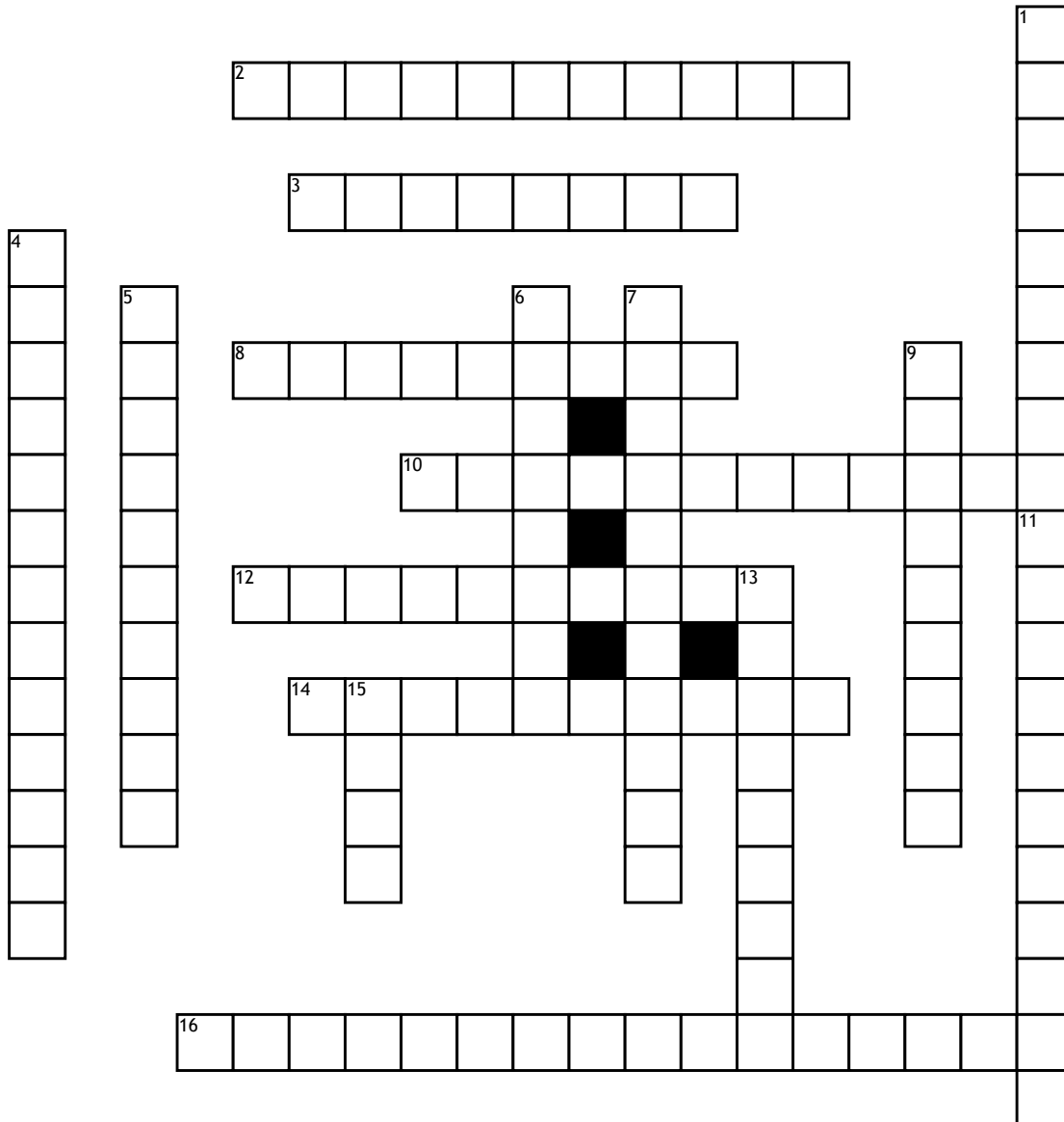

- 2. The belief that God is all powerful.
- 3. "In the image of God" The belief that human beings are uniquely a reflection of Gods personhood. Unlike other animals, human beings are rational, free and moral.
- 8. Pain or loss which harms human beings. Some suffering is caused by other human beings (often called moral evil) and some is not (often called Natural evil)
- 10. The duty to care for creation responsibly as stewards rather than consumers and to protect it for future generations.

- 1. The quality of being like God seeking the well-being of others selflessly.

- 5. The moral laws of right and wrong which are universal and not dependent on human laws. The belief in the natural law is that the moral law is discoverbale by every human being and is the same for all human being in all places at all times.
