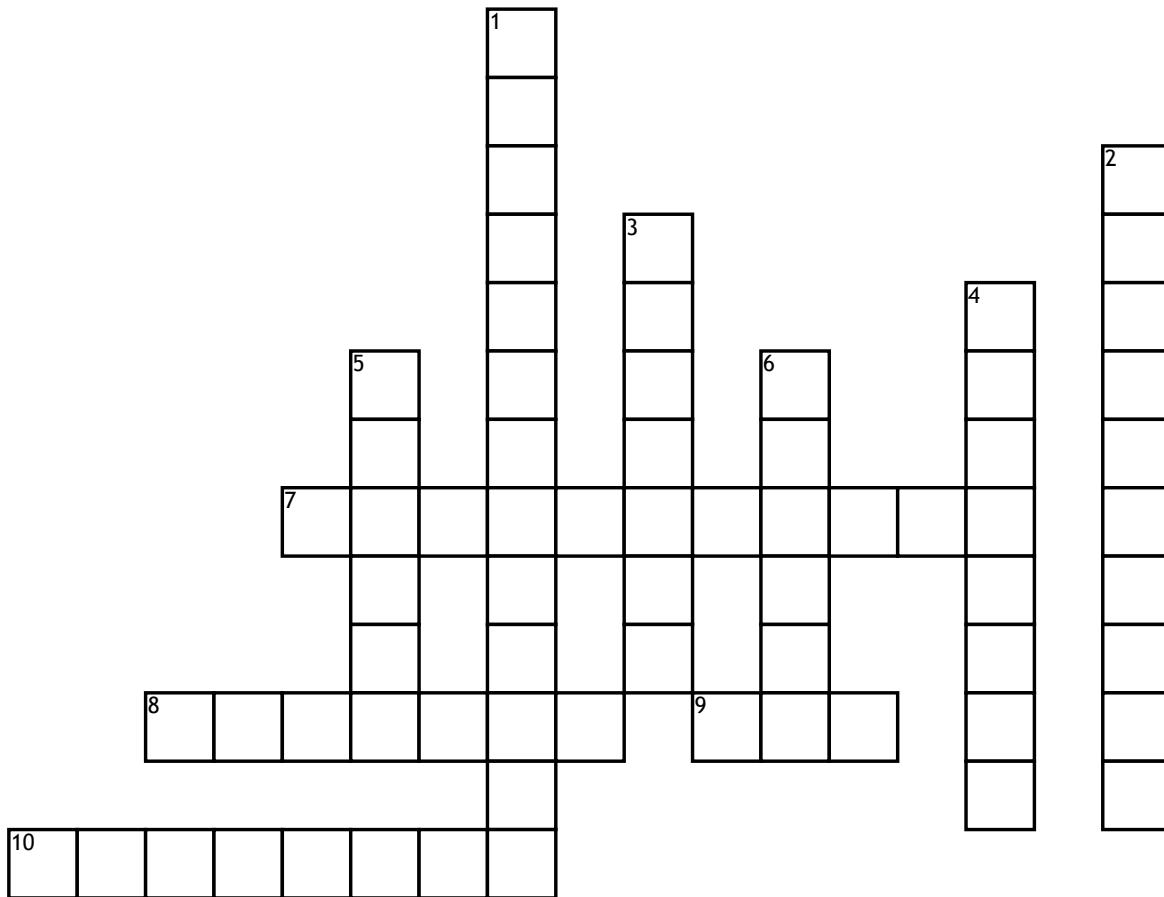

7. An ongoing program designed to prevent periodontal disease from recurring for patients who have undergone periodontal treatment.
8. Instrument used to scrape sub gingivally to remove calculus
9. Abbreviation for : periodontist removes plaque and calculus from the periodontal pocket and around the tooth
10. Hardened dental plaque. Calculus (or tartar) is usually hard, rough and porous

1. Disease involving bone loss around the teeth
2. The first stage of periodontal disease.
3. Localized collection of pus in a cavity formed by the disintegration of tissues
4. tissue that covers the tooth root and blends with the periodontal ligament to hold the tooth in place.
5. A sticky, colorless film that constantly forms on the teeth.
6. instrument used to scrape supra gingivally to remove calculus and plaque.
