

- **7.** An ongoing program designed to prevent periodontal disease from recurring for patients who have undergone periodontal treatment.
- **8.** Instrument used to scrape sub gingivally to remove calculus
- **9.** Abbreviation for : periodontist removes plaque and calculus from the periodontal pocket and around the tooth
- **10.** Hardened dental plaque. Calculus (or tartar) is usually hard, rough and porous

- 1. Disease involving bone loss around the teeth
- 2. The first stage of periodontal disease.
- **3.** Localized collection of pus in a cavity formed by the disintegration of tissues
- **4.** tissue that covers the tooth root and blends with the periodontal ligament to hold the tooth in place.
- **5.** A sticky, colorless film that constantly forms on the teeth.
- **6.** insrument used to scrapesupra gingivally to remove calculus and plaque.
