

- 5. White powder appears on leaves
- **8.** Adults are delicate, grayish black, mosquito-like flies (1/8 inch long) with long legs and one pair of clear wings
- **9.** manifest as distorted, streaked or mottled leaves, or by diminishing plant growth and flowering
- **10.** Adults are moth-like insects with powdery white wings and short antenna
- **11.** Adults are reddish brown or pale in color, oval-shaped and very small

- **12.** small , soft bodied, pear-shaped insects that may be green, yellow, brown, red or black in
- **13.** They can be as much as 1/16 inch long but before reaching maturity are just a fraction this size
- **14.** Adults are often black to gray flies with yellow stripes and clear wings

Gray Mold/Botrytis

- 1. Resembles fuzzy gray mold
- 2. Secrete a hard protective covering (1/8 inch long) over themselves, which is not attached to the body

Mealybug

- **3.** Adults are very small straw-colored or black slender insects with two pairs of feathery wings
- **4.** Super super small they are simalir looking to leaf aphids
- **6.** Adults are soft, oval distinctly segmented insects that are usually covered with a white or gray mealy
- **7.** tapered, translucent, wedge-shaped cylinders that take on a yellow tint
- **15.** no circulation throughout roots so they begin to rot
