
plant: roots, stems, and leaves

- 1. absorbs water, and is the outer layer of the root
- 3. the type of root that is thin and branches out
- 8. the type of root that never touches the ground
- 10. moves surgars in the plants UP and DOWN
- 11. a root with one main stall in the ground

- 12. a plant with hard uncovered seeds
- 13. stores food and nutrients in the roots
- 14. transports or carries nutrients in roots
- 15. this is covered with bark
