

- 3. Poetry written in either rhyme or unrhymed lines that have no set fixed metrical pattern.
- 5. a French verse form that is made up of five three-line stanzas and a final quatrain.
- 12. An extensive, serious poem that tells the story about a heroic figure
- 13. A subversion of the sonnet that takes cues from the ghazal
- 14. one of the oldes types of poems, also very straightforward
- 15. originated in Italy and derives its name from the Italian word "sonetto"
- 16. started as a Malaysian folk poem and grew and changed as it was adapted by western writers

- 18. A poem written about one self's life
- 19. its actually not a form poem it's just a term for any poem that takes a visual image or work of art as its inspiration.
- 20. This type of poem is two lines which may be rhymed or unrhymed.

- 1. more recent form invented by poet Terrance Hayes,
- 2. an Arabic form of verse poem that was adopted by medieval Persian poets like Hafez and Rumi
- 4. A poem that has five lines and creates a mood, picture, or feeling. Lines 1 through 4 are made up of words, phrases or clauses while the first word of each line is in alphabetical order

- Poetry written in the shape or form of an object
- 7. Also known as "size poetry"
- 8. A sonnet consisting of an octave with the rhyme pattern abbaabba followed by six lines with a rhyme pattern of cdecde or cdcdcd.
- 9. A poem written in unrhymed iambic pentameter and is often unobtrusive.
- 10. type of Japanese poetry that is derived from the longer renga form
- 11. A rhyming poem has the repetition of the same or similar sounds of two or more words, often at the end of the line.
