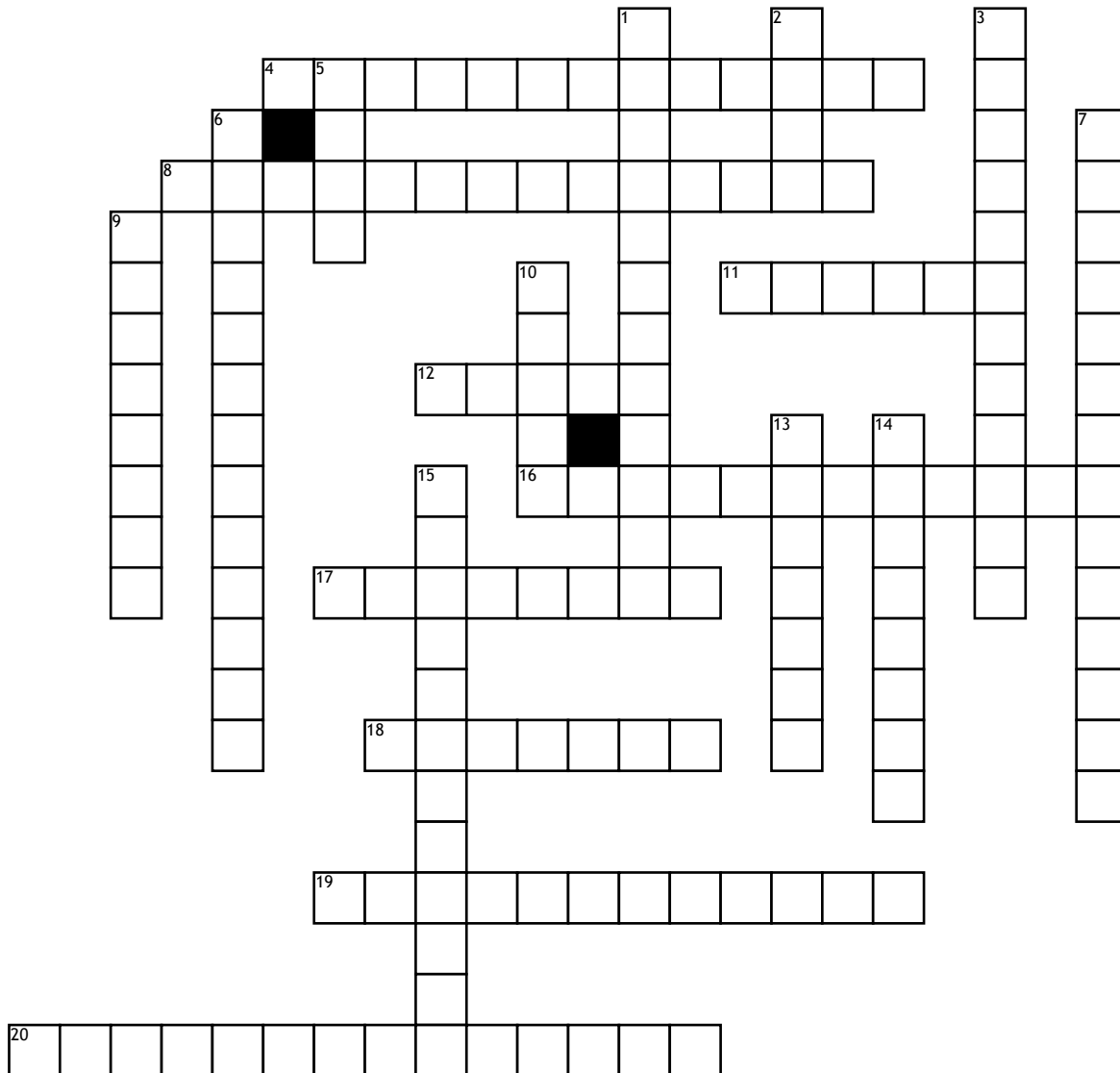

1. primary moon phase when half of the moon's surface is illuminated
 2. the natural satellite of the earth
 3. an eclipse in which the sun is obscured by the moon
 5. a real or imaginary line on which something rotates, or a straight line around which things are evenly arranged

6. less illuminated than a full moon but larger than the moon at third quarter

7. an eclipse of a celestial body in which only part of the luminary is obscured or darkened

9. the phase of the moon in which its whole disk is illuminated

10. the curved path of a celestial object or spacecraft around a star, planet, or moon, especially a periodic elliptical revolution

13. first phase of the moon

14. two full moons in one month

15. an eclipse in which the moon appears darkened as it passes into the earth's shadow
