

- **3.** typically form at the base of steep, rocky cliffs. sections of rocks that are wedged and many fall into larger piles
- 5. flows of mud that move quickly
- **8.** slowest mass movement, moves a few cm max each year
- **10.** weathering caused by decreasing pressure on a rocks surface, slabs of outer rock breaks which eventually cause a breakup off into layers
