

 6. raised U.S. tariffs on over 20,000 imported goods to record levels.
 7. a series of thirty important radio broadcasts made by Franklin D. Roosevelt as a means to directly talk to Americans in times of crisis and national importance.
 8. period of severe dust storms that greatly damaged the ecology and agriculture of the American and Canadian prairies during the 1930s;
 9. a public work relief program which employed young men to perform unskilled work in rural areas; under United States Army supervision. It began in 1933 and ended in 1942.

10. October 29, 1929, when panicked sellers traded nearly 16 million shares on the New York Stock Exchange
 11. the process of returning a person back to one's place of origin or citizenship.
 12. a prime New Deal agency established by U.S. president Franklin D. Roosevelt (FDR) in 1933.
 14. the purchase of an asset with the hope that it will become more valuable at a future date.
 15. a legal entity created through the laws of its state of incorporation.
 16. a federal government relief agency that was created under the Emergency Relief Appropriation Act of April 1935 to provide public employment.

 3. New Deal government agency (1933-39) designed to reduce unemployment and increase purchasing power through the construction of highways and public buildings.

 5. a law enacted in 1935 to create a system of transfer payments in which younger, working people support older, retired people.
