

1. the occurrence of a natural electrical discharge of very short duration and high voltage between a cloud and the ground or within a cloud, accompanied by a bright flash and typically also thunder.

9. a body of air with horizontally uniform temperature, humidity, and pressure.

11. a big funnel connecting from the clouds to the ground

12. a colorless, transparent, odorless, tasteless liquid that forms the seas, lakes, rivers, and rain and is the basis of the fluids of living organisms.

7. a violent disturbance of the atmosphere with strong winds and usually rain, thunder, lightning, or snow.
8. an overflowing of a large amount of water beyond its normal confines, especially over what is normally dry land.

10. a form of precipitation consisting of ice pellets, often mixed with rain or snow.
