

- 1. international organization that was created to promote world peace and cooperation that was created by the treaty of Versailles

- **4.** a policy of not supporting either side in an argument, fight, or war between other powers.
- **5.** treaty signed after world war 1 had ended in 1918.

- 7. German submarines used during world war 1 and world war 2 against enemy naval warships and used to cut off enemy supply ships
- **8.** an agreement between opposing armies to suspend hostilities to discuss peace terms.

- **12.** the alliance between Great Britain , France, and Russia during WWI . also known as the Triple Entente.
