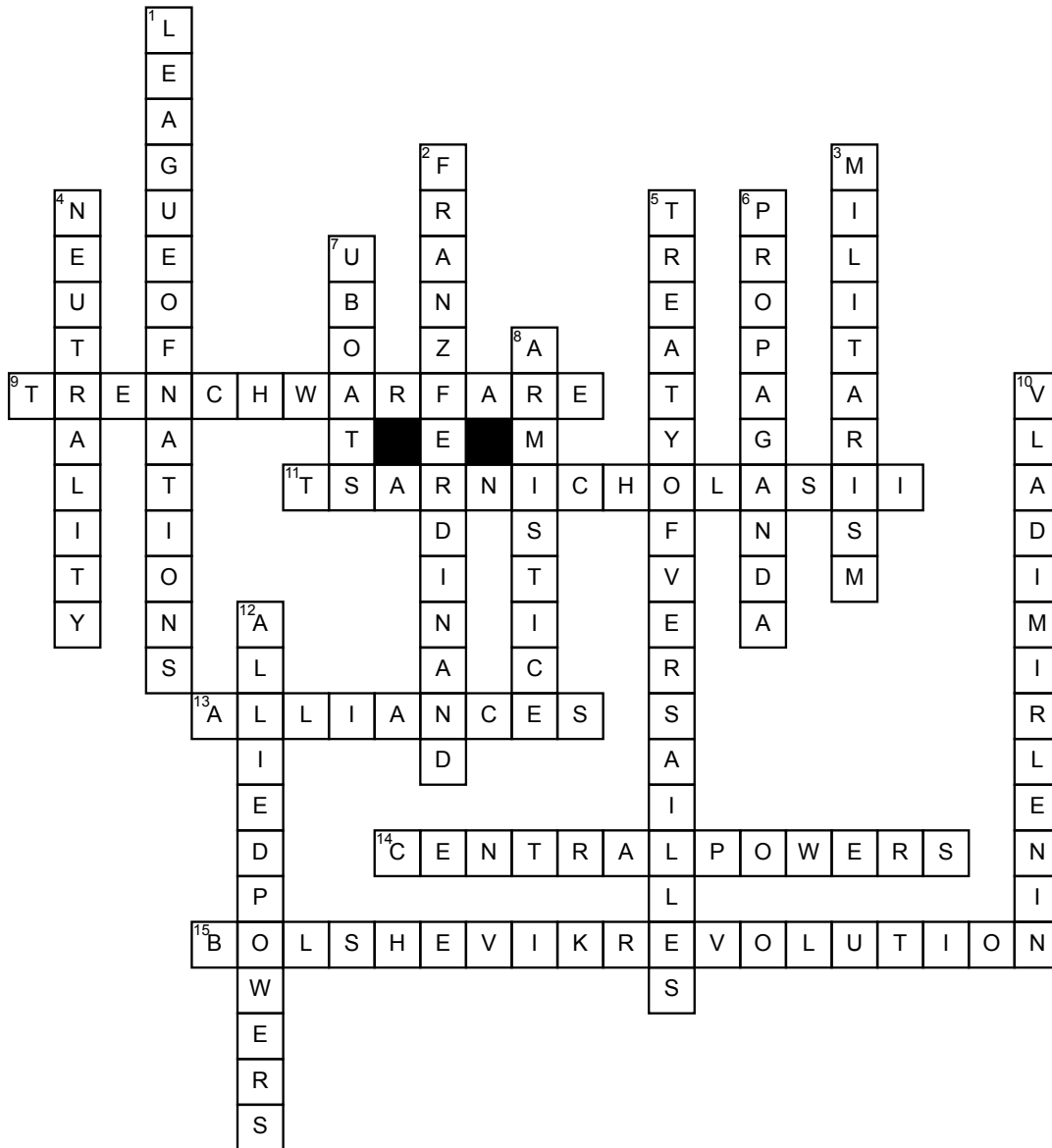

**1.** international organization that was created to promote world peace and cooperation that was created by the treaty of Versailles

**2.** heir to the Austria-Hungary throne and was assassinated by Gavrillo Principe in 1914. his death was the spark that started WWI.

**3.** glorification of the military. one of the main causes of war.

**4.** a policy of not supporting either side in an argument, fight, or war between other powers.

**5.** treaty signed after world war 1 had ended in 1918.

**6.** information, especially of a biased or misleading nature, used to promote or publicize a particular political cause or point of view.

**7.** German submarines used during world war 1 and world war 2 against enemy naval warships and used to cut off enemy supply ships

**8.** an agreement between opposing armies to suspend hostilities to discuss peace terms.

**10.** founder of the Russian Communist Party and leader of the Bolshevik Revolution

**12.** the alliance between Great Britain, France, and Russia during WWI. also known as the Triple Entente.
